b. Eligibility of Youth Delegates

(i) Between the ages of 18 and 30 years old

- (ii) Full-time undergraduate or graduate school student
- (iii) Proficient in English (suggested TOEFL iBT score: 90, IELTS 7.0)
- (iv) Interested in international relations, development, and SDGs related fields
- (v) Able to participate in the entire program from 9 August to 13 August 2018

4. EXPENSES / FLIGHT ARRANGEMENT / VISA

- a. The participants will bear the costs of international airfare and travel insurance. Flight should be arranged from home to Tokyo (Narita International Airport or Haneda Airport) arriving on 9 August 2018. Early arrival is not permitted, however, late departure will be at participant's own expenses.
- b. Selected participants will be asked to **book flight tickets before 30 June 2018** and submit the itinerary to the Organizing Committee.
- c. The organizers will bear the hospitality costs of accommodation during the program (check-in on 9 August, check-out on 13 August), local transportation, breakfast and lunch expenses, reception dinner fees (on 9 August and 13 August).
- d. For those who require visa to enter Japan, please indicate it in the application form. Once your group is selected, the Organizing Committee will contact you regarding necessary procedures.

- □ You must not edit the video, no added effects or BGM.
- □ Shoot the video so that each of your faces are clearly visible.
- □ The video can be sent either as a file or included as a Youtube link in the submission email.
